Singular and Plural Nouns



A **singular noun** names one person, place, or thing. A **plural noun** names more than one person, place, or thing. Add **-s** to form the plural of most nouns.

Add **-es** to form the plural of nouns that end in **ss, x, ch, or sh**.

If a noun ends in a consonant and y, change the **y** to **i** and add **-es** to form the plural.
