PREPOSITIONS

Preposition is used to show **place/position or movement/direction**. They are usually used before nouns and pronouns.

A. Prepositions showing position:

on, in, above, under, in front of, behind

Example:

1.



The cat is **under** the chair.

2.



The apple is **on** the box.

3.



The bird is flying **above** the tree.

The monkey is **in** the cage.

5.



The boy is **in front of** the television.

The girl is hiding **behind** the curtain.

B. Preposition showing movement:

to, from


Example:
