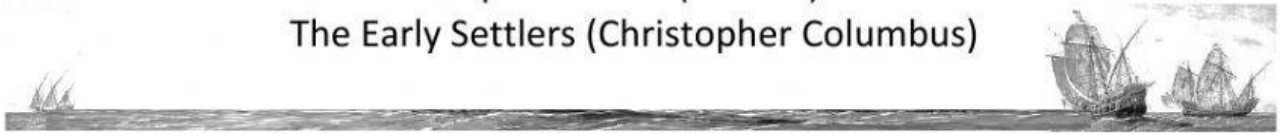

The Early Settlers (Christopher Columbus)



Read the passage below. Follow instructions to answer the questions.

Christopher Columbus was born in Italy. He knew that the earth was round and he wanted to find a shorter sea route to India by going west. He needed ships, men and money to make the long voyage. The King and Queen of Spain agreed to help him. They hoped he would find lots of gold, which would make their country **wealthy** or rich. They gave him three ships. They were The Nina, The Pinta and The Santa Maria. On 12th October 1492, the three ships arrived at an island, which the Lucayan people called Guanahani. Columbus renamed the island San Salvador.

A few years later, other Spanish ships came. They killed many Lucayans. They also made some Lucayans their **slaves**. This means that the Lucayans worked without pay. Soon, all the Lucayans had died and the Spanish people went back to Spain. No one lived in the Bahamas for a long time.
