PRESENT SIMPLE	PRESENT CONTINUOUS
(+) My mother listens to music	(+) My mother is listening to music
(-) My mother doesn't listen to music	(-) My mother isn't listening to music.
(?) Does my mother listen to music?	(?) Is my mother listening to music?
- Yes, she does	- Yes, she is
- No, she doesn't	- No, she isn't

TIME EXPRESSIONS

PRESENT SIMPLE	PRESENT CONTINUOUS
- On Mondays - In summer - At 9:00 - Every day / sometimes	- Now - At the moment - Right now
