How to make slime with glue

Squeeze eight drops of food coloring into a bowl. (Add more or less, depending on the shade you want.) Mix the glue, baking soda and food coloring until there are no white streaks. Add 1 tablespoon of lens cleaner. If you don't have lens cleaner, you can use contact lens cleaner instead. Stir your slime mixture with a spoon until it starts to thicken. Personalize this slime recipe with clear glue or fun mix-ins such as glitter and confetti. Put both of your hands into the mixing bowl and start kneading the slime. Add about 1/4 tablespoon of lens cleaner if the slime is too sticky. Rotate between kneading and adding lens cleaner until the consistency is right. Store your slime in an airtight plastic bag, reusable plastic container or glass jar.
