| <b>Present Simple</b>     | <b>*Form:</b><br>- I <u>make</u> a jewelry every day. ( <b>I / You / We / They / Plural noun + V<sub>0</sub></b> )<br>- He <u>makes</u> a jewelry every day. ( <b>He / She / It / Singular noun + V<sub>s/es</sub></b> )<br><b>*Hint:</b> every, always/usually/often/sometimes/never, once /twice/three times ... a week   |
| <b>Present Continuous</b> | <b>*Form:</b><br><b>S + am/is/are + V-ing</b><br>- I <u>am making</u> jewelry at the moment.<br>- He <u>is making</u> jewelry at the moment.<br><b>*Hint:</b> now, at the moment, at present, Look! Listen! Be careful!   |
| <b>Past Simple</b>        | <b>*Form:</b><br><b>S + V<sub>2/ed</sub></b><br>- I <u>made</u> jewelry yesterday. / He <u>made</u> jewelry yesterday.<br>- I <u>loved</u> jewelry when I was young. / She <u>loved</u> jewelry when she was young.<br><b>*Hint:</b> yesterday, last, ago   |
| <b>Past Continuous</b>    | <b>*Form:</b><br><b>S + was/were + V-ing</b><br>- I <u>was making</u> jewelry at 6 o'clock yesterday.<br>- I <u>was making</u> jewelry when my father came home. (Hành động chen ngang chia thì quá khứ đơn)<br>- I <u>was making</u> jewelry while my mother was making pottery. (Hành động cùng xảy ra và cùng kéo dài chia thì quá khứ tiếp diễn.)<br><b>*Hint:</b> 6 o'clock yesterday, at this time yesterday, when, while |
