Modals

Modal	Used	Example
Must , have to + v(inf)	to express <u>obligation</u> in the present and the future The past tense of <u>must</u> and <u>have to</u> → <u>had to</u> .	You must stop at the 'STOP' sign. You have to slow down at this junction.
Mustn't +v(inf)	Mustn't = <u>not allowed</u> to do something. No past tense of mustn't.	You mustn't (must not) arrive late to work.
have to and need to+ v(inf)	express necessity	I need to/have to finish a report for work.
needn't, don't have to, don't need to + v(inf)	express lack of necessity .	-I don't need to hand it -I needn't hand it -I needed to finish a report for work
