- Architect's World: What are your favorite home design?

- Michael Chan: I really like Japanese designs. Many people in Japan build interesting houses. For example, the house is very tall and has a steep roof. The windows on the roof are different sizes. Inside the house, the rooms are very narrow, and the ceilings are very high. It is very simple inside.

- Architect's World: What do you think about "green" homes?

- Michael Chan: It is very important to build houses that are good for the Earth. My favorite example is a house in Saigon, Vietnam. It is a "garden home." This house is in the middle of a busy city, but there are plants everywhere. From the street, people see a tall garden. But, in fact, it is a house. There are plants and trees in front of the glass walls. There is also a small garden on top of the roof. You can put chairs and a table there and enjoy tea with your family.

- Architect's World: What do architects use to build houses?
- Michael Chan: Many architects use wood. It keeps your house warm in the winter. They also use metal and glass. Sometimes they use something different. For example, one architect from Amsterdam puts mirrors on every wall of a house. Other architects use glass or even plastic for the walls.
