Vietnamese traditional Theatre

Despite being strongly influenced by Chinese opera and other art forms, Vietnamese theatre with three special (1) _____ - Tuong singing, Cheo singing and Cai Luong singing has been modified to be suitable for Vietnamese people.

Tuong singing is a form of art imported from China around the 13th century.
