Exercise 4:


(a) You want to make candles to sell during a Family Day event at your school. Read the information below. Then complete 4 (b)

You will need:

- old candle stubs or old candles
- hammer
- metal can
- large saucepan
- pencil
- moulds (like glass jars, small glass cups)
- dye and/or scents for candle-making



Here are the steps to make the homemade candles:



(b) Sequence the steps of making the homemade candles in order. Put the numbers in the boxes next to the sentences.

First, break the candle stubs into smaller pieces with a hammer. Remove any old wicks.	
You may add a fragrance or dye to the wax.	
Then, place a wick into the mould.	
Next, put the can into the saucepan and melt the wax over a low fire.	
Finally, let it cool thoroughly. Leave it in the mould or remove it from the mould.	
Third, fill the saucepan halfway with water and place it on the stove.	
Next, place the pencil horizontally across the rim of the jar or can to keep the wick in place.	
Second, put the pieces of wax into the metal can.	
After that, pour the melted wax into your mould carefully.	
Tie one end to a pencil and knots it tightly.
