In the Malay language, Orangutans means "men of the forest" that live in the lowland jungle privately. They usually eat wild fruits such as mangosteens and figs. According to a research, their favourite fruit is the durian feasibly because of the strong taste and smell of it. Orangutans also drink fresh water from holes in trees. They make their own nests in trees where they rest during the day and sleep at night.

There are two types of male Orangutan. Flanged males have expanded cheek pads, called flanges and they are also able to make a loud sound called long calls via their throat sac. Meanwhile, an unflanged male, looks like an adult female of Orangutan.

Bornean and Sumatran are two well-known species of Orangutans that have bushy reddish fur. The difference between the two are, Sumatran Orangutans have longer facial hair and tend to have closer social bonds compared to Bornean Orangutans. However, both species are facing sharp population declines. It is reported that probably there were more than 230,000 Orangutans a century ago but recently, the estimated number of existing Bornean Orangutans is roughly 104,700, while Sumatran Orangutans which are considered as endangered species, is about 7,500.

In November 2017, a third species of Orangutan called Tapanuli, was declared. With not more than 800 numbers of this particular Orangutans in existence, Tapanuli Orangutans are considered as the most endangered of all Orangutans.
