Short adjectives and Long adjectives

Short adjectives (tính từ ngắn)	Long adjectives (tính từ dài)
Tính từ ngắn là những tính từ gồm 1 âm tiết.	Tính từ dài là những tính từ gồm từ 2 âm tiết trở lên

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - nice - long - happy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - intelligent - beautiful - expensive
<p>Để chuyển sang dạng so sánh ta thêm “r/er” vào cuối tính từ ấy.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - nice → nicer - long → longer <p>Nếu tận cùng của tính từ là “y”, ta đổi “y” → “ier”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - dry drier - happy → happier 	<p>Để chuyển sang dạng so sánh ta thêm “more” lên trước tính từ dài.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - intelligent → more intelligent - expensive → more expensive

Với các tính từ kết thúc bằng -ed, -ing, -ful, -less, khi chuyển sang dạng so sánh hơn, ta đều coi nó là tính từ dài

bored → more bored

interesting → more interesting

careful → more careful

helpless → more helpless

Với các tính từ kết thúc bằng một nguyên âm đơn + phụ âm đơn, ta gấp đôi phụ âm

hot → hotter

big → bigger

Các tính từ đặc biệt khác

old → older/elder (già)

good → better (tốt)

far → farther/ further (xa)

bad → worse (tồi)

a. Comparative of short adjectives

S + be + adj-er + than ...

Ví dụ: Phong is taller than Trang. (*Phong cao hơn Trang.*)

Long is bigger than Quan. (*Long to hơn Quân.*)

b. Comparative of long adjectives

S + be + more + adj + than ...

Ví dụ:

Thang is more intelligent than Hung. (*Thăng thông minh hơn Hùng.*)

Your house is more modern than my house. (*Ngôi nhà của bạn hiện đại hơn ngôi nhà của tôi.*)
