

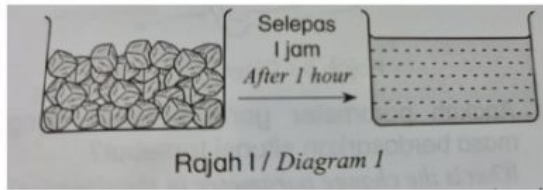

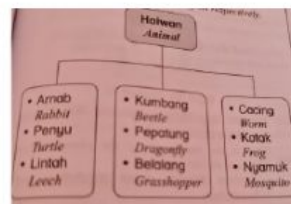


3. Diagram II shows two activities in human breathing.



What are the organs involved in the process above?

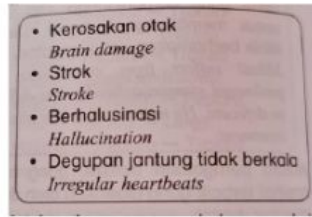
