The following steps will show you how to operate a Rice Cooker properly.

- Wash the cooking pot and make sure the inner side is clean.
- Measure the rice by using the measurement cup and put the rice into the cooking pot. Make sure to give space for the rice, water and the expansion.
- Rinse the rice so that we can remove the pesticides that may be present.
- Add some water into the cooking pot, usually we need to see the water is 1cm above the rice surface.
- Soak the rice for about 30 minnutes in order to make the cooked rice stickier.
- Put the cooking pot along with the rice and water into the Rice Cooker.
- Close the Rice Cooker lid and then plug the cable into the electricity socket.
- Start the Rice Cooker by pressing the Cooking/Timer Button.
- Wait until the cooking process is over.
