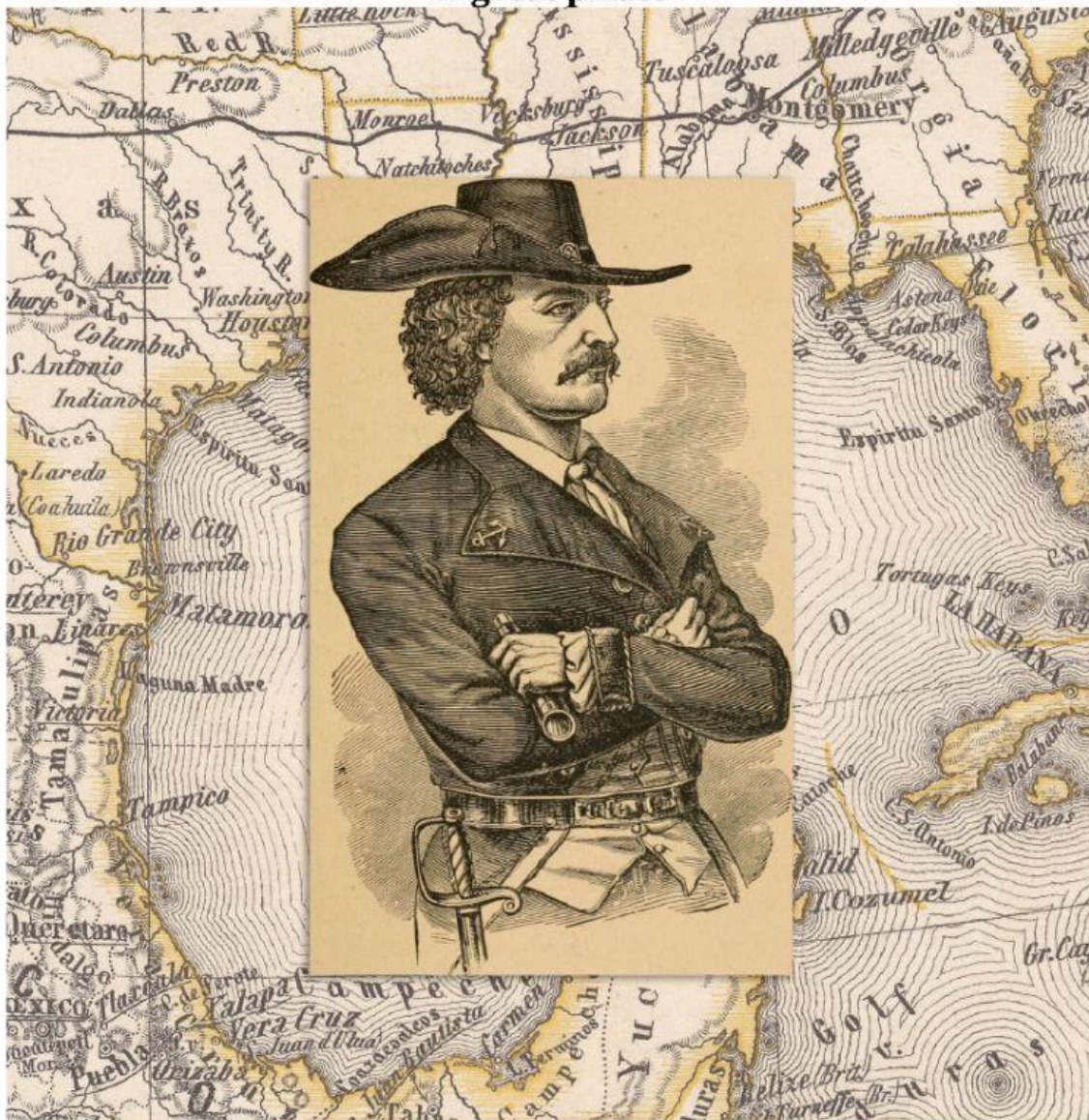

A great pirate



Born in 1780, Jean Lafitte, together with his brother,
The Lafitte brothers earned a reputation for piracy because they sometimes attacked Spanish ships
in the Gulf, but it was smuggling. The local Governor Claiborne of
Louisiana had been trying to imprison the heads of illegal smuggling operations, which included
Lafitte, before the start of the war.

During the War of 1812, which saw the English fight against the United States, Lafitte was
approached by the English. They planned to capture New Orleans and offered to
and pay him \$30,000 for his services.

Pretending to think about taking the offer, Lafitte waited for the English to leave and then
. He offered to help protect Louisiana.

Claiborne, ignored the offer. Sometime after, an American warship
attacked and destroyed Lafitte's base and captured 80 of his men.
Claiborne offered a \$500 reward. When Lafitte saw this he made similar
posters calling for the governor's capture and offering a bigger sum of \$5,000.
