7. Dominic, Joshua and Isaiah helped an old lady pick mangoes from her tree. She told them that they could each take 3 mangoes home. How many mangoes did she allow them to take home in all?

8. Each box holds 28 tins of evaporated milk and there are 5 of these boxes in the storeroom. How many tins of milk are in that room in all?

9. I baked some cookies and placed them on a large baking tray. There were 39 rows in all and each row had 4 cookies. How many cookies did I bake altogether?

10. Gabrielle's mother gave her \$10 to take to school on Monday, Wednesday and Friday last week. How much money was Gabrielle given to take to school in all?
