



THE PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

STRUCTURE:

(+) S + have / has + been + Ving

(-) S + haven't / hasn't + been + Ving

(?) Have/ Has + S + been + Ving+.....?

Yes, S + have /has.

No, S + haven't / hasn't.

(WH?) Wh + have /has + S + been + Ving ?

We use this tense ;

(1) to talk about activities which started in the past and haven't finished

e.g. I have been teaching English since 1995. / I'm still teaching

e.g. Begüm has been living in London since 2020 / She is still living in London.

Time expressions are since , for , all morning,etc

(2) to talk about the present result of a recent past activity. The action finished in the past and lasted for some time. The result of the action is visible in the present.

e.g. He is dirty. He has been playing with mud. (He is no longer playing with mud but the fact that his clothes are dirty is visible now)

e.g. Kivanç is exhausted. He's been studying non-stop.

e.g. It has been raining. The grass is wet. However, it stopped raining.

Note: With the verbs feel(have a particular emotion) , live , work and teach we can use the present perfect or present perfect continuous with no difference in meaning.

Note: You shouldn't use STATE VERBS with PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS (like, know, hate, belong, own, want, understand etc)
