(to join TWO sentences that relate back to the same person/thing)

Who	Which
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>used for people (digunakan untuk ORANG)</li><li>before a verb (SEBELUM kata kerja)</li></ul> <p>The woman called yesterday. She wants to buy the house.</p> <p></p> <p>The woman <u>who</u> called yesterday wants to buy the house.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>used for things and animals (digunakan untuk BENDA dan HAIWAN)</li></ul> <p>This is the car. Alex wants to buy the car.</p> <p></p> <p>This is the car <u>which</u> Alex wants to buy</p>
