The son and daughter of a poor wood-cutter are abandoned in the woods and get lost. They find a house made of gingerbread, cakes, sweets, and many other treats and pastries. They are soon kidnapped by the witch living here, who wants to eat them. They manage to escape outwitting the witch.

A miller falsely tells the King that his daughter can spin straw into gold. The King locks the girl in a room and forces her to prove her abilities or die. She is helped by a strange little man, in exchange for her necklace, her ring, and finally, the promise of her first-born child.

A gingerbread man is chased by various pursuers who want to eat him: an old woman, an old man, farm animals (a pig, a cow, a horse). He is finally eaten by a fox.

An old wood-carver carves a wooden puppet who is brought to life by a blue fairy. He will become a real boy if he proves himself to be "brave, truthful and unselfish".
