Panama's National Holidays are based on religion or on historical dates. On most of these official holidays, banks, public offices and many businesses are closed. Streets shut down, parades and typical acts are held to celebrate these important dates.

Let's describe some Panamanian Holidays:

- November 3<sup>rd</sup>: Separation of Panama from Colombia

The Separation of Panama from Colombia was formalized on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1903 with the establishment of the Republic. On November 3<sup>rd</sup> begins the Panamanian national parties and celebration with parades all over the country.



- November 4<sup>th</sup>: National Symbols Day

On November 4<sup>th</sup>, Panamanians commemorate the day of Patriotic Symbols with parades. Different schools, national police, presidential guards and different organizations participate. The symbols are: National Anthem, Coat of Arms and the Flag. There are many other elements that characterized the nation, such as the Holy Ghost Orchid, The Harpy Eagle and the Balboa's currency.



- November 28<sup>th</sup>: Independence Day from Spain

On this day in 1821, Panama gained full independence from Spain. The country then joined up with Colombia for 80 years, finally becoming the independent nation we know today.
