

Mark Inglis was born in 1959 in New Zealand.

10 When he was a boy, he had a dream: he wanted to climb Mount Everest. But in 1982, his life changed. Mark was climbing Mount Cook¹ when the weather changed suddenly. After 13 days, a rescue team² found Mark. He was freezing cold.

15 They took him to the hospital. Mark had bad frostbite³ and he lost both of his legs.
