

## CONNECTORS OF CONSEQUENCE

They express the consequence of an action or of a situation.

Punctuation signs are important, and these connectors are usually between pauses.

Look at these examples.

She didn't like the atmosphere. She left the party.

= She didn't like the atmosphere, **so** she left the party

= She didn't like the atmosphere. { **Therefore,**  
**As a result,**  
**Consequently,**  
**In consequence,** } she left the party



Descartes

"I think, therefore, I am"
