Lesson 1

Family in Islam-Family is considered as the corner stone of the Islamic Society.

The atmosphere in the family is based on:

1. **Sacrifice** – it is a physical act of faith. It also means spending one's money and things in the path of God. The sacrifice is one of the forms of giving in Islam.
2. **Love** – love is important to maintain family ties. This is having a good relation with one's relatives, to love, respect and help them.
3. **Loyalty** - faithfulness to commitments or obligations. Islam urges love and peace between husband and wife.
4. **Obedience** - is essential in every family between children and their parents. In Islam, showing obedience to parents is the fastest way of earning blessings from them and from God (Allah).

Traditional family – is composed of Father, Mother and Children.

Extended family – A Traditional family together with grandparents.

How does Islam organize a family-We have to focus on husband – wife relationship and parent – children relationship.

Lesson 2

Husband-wife Relationship described as:

A relationship with

1. Tranquility – means a state of peace.
2. Love – characterized by deep respect and loyalty.
3. Mercy - is a capacity to forgive or showing kindness, which is like forgiveness.

Qur'an describes Husband-wife relationship as garments that provides comfort, modesty and protection.

Marriage is the base of society and family life.

Modesty –the quality of not being too proud or confident about yourself or your abilities.

Consciousness – refers to your individual awareness of your unique thoughts, memories, feelings, sensations, and environments.

Lesson 3

Cooperation- is one of the most important features of creatures in this world.

Creatures – means the humans and animals. No creature could ever live alone without the help from similar creatures and even animals need cooperation to survive in the jungle, same as Humans. Humans need each other to live.

Remember that Man cannot live without cooperating with others, this means that all kind of profession or any occupation are important in the society.

Profession- means a paid occupation, especially one that involves trainings and formal education.

Occupation- means any job with or without formal training or education.

Life will stop if there is no cooperation because there will be no peace and unity.

Lesson 4

Gift giving is one of the good manners that keeps and strengthens relations between the giver and the receiver. One of the acts that prophet Muhammad (PBUH) advised Muslims to do. Gift giving strengthens the relationship because it creates a bond of love and care between two people – the giver and the receiver.

Hadiths teaches us: If someone gifts you something you should gift them something which should be better or at least be equal to what they gifted and if someone does not have enough money to return the gift then he should pray to God to give that person more blessings.
