

Reflexive Pronouns

We use a reflexive pronoun to refer to the same person or thing in the same sentence.

	Pronouns	Reflexive Pronouns	
<u>Singular</u>	{ I You He She It	{ myself yourself himself herself itself	
<u>Plural</u>	{ You We They	{ yourselves ourselves themselves	

Example: I smiled to myself. Jack and Tom are talking to themselves.
