Division Property of Equality(noun)	any equation that can be written in the form A x + B y = C where A and B cannot both be 0
coefficient(noun)	a mathematical statement that the values of two expressions are equal
Addition Property of Equality(noun)	subtracting the same number from each side of an equation results in an equivalent equation
Subtraction Property of Equality(noun)	a number placed before a variable that is multiplied by the variable
