
Countable nouns / Uncountable nouns



Countable nouns- are for things we can count using numbers; **items that can be counted**, even if the number might be extraordinarily high.

For example:


- a slice of bread
- an apple
- two melons



Uncountable nouns- are nouns that come in a state or quantity that is **impossible to count; cannot be counted**.

For example:

- some bread
- hair
- salt
