Key Concepts

Assessment

To assess the performance of laboratories for their conduct of specific test, measurements or calibrations.

Informal Assessment

To assess a student's relative strengths and weaknesses in a given subject and the results provide an analysis of students' proficiency.

Formal Assessment

A test to determine a student's current skill level and is usually associated with a grade level

Proficiency Test

To measure skills and knowledge learned in a given grade level, usually through planned instruction, such as training or classroom instruction.

Achievement test

Is a written knowledge exam (usually involving multiple-choice questions) and usually twice to four times yearly throughout the entire academic program.

Progress test

To collect information about learners' performance, progress or attitudes in order to make judgements about their learning.

Placement test

To get other information about the progress of individual students, we can take a class test.

Diagnostic test

Take an assessment during a lesson by monitoring and observing students as they perform ordinary classroom activities.
