The Northern Lights in Iceland

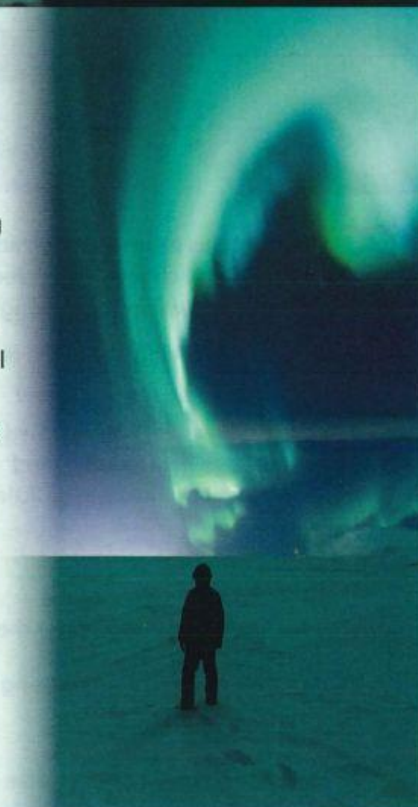
