MUST/MUSTN'T & CAN/CAN'T

A. Choose between *must* / *mustn't* / *can* / *can't*.

1. Students **must** / **mustn't** / **can** / **can't** leave their house common rooms until 6 am.
2. Students **must** / **mustn't** / **can** / **can't** join the Duelling Club.
3. Students **must** / **mustn't** / **can** / **can't** have a dog at Hogwarts.
4. Students **must** / **mustn't** / **can** / **can't** listen when classmates or teachers are talking.

B. Put the words in order.

e.g. *must* / *a uniform* / *wear* / *Students* → *Students must wear a uniform.*

1. *mustn't* / *the Black Lake* / *swim* / *Students* / *in* →
2. *raise* / *must* / *to speak* / *their hands* / *Students* →
3. *the Quidditch team* / *Students* / *join* / *can* →
4. *First years* / *their own* / *bring* / *can't* / *broomsticks* →

C. Rephrase to use *must* / *mustn't* / *can* / *can't*.

e.g. *Students are allowed to bring a cat.* → *Students can bring a cat.*
