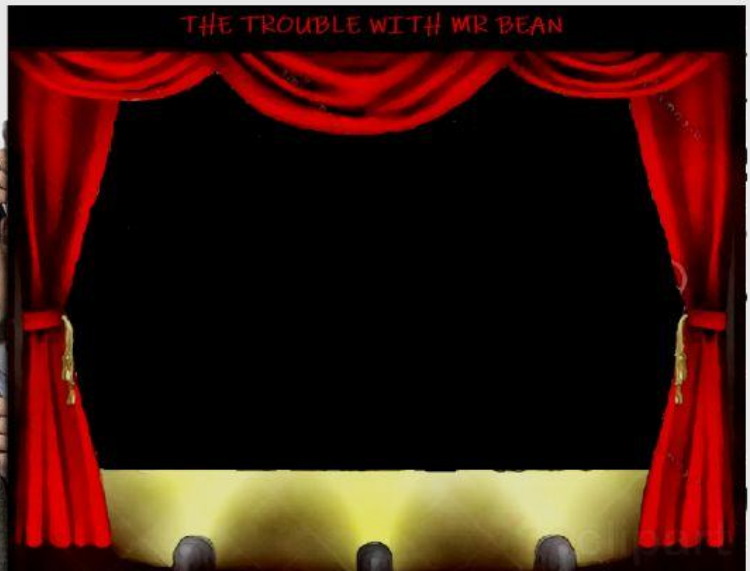


PRESENT SIMPLE & PRESENT CONTINUOUS
