Phát âm là /iz/

- /s/ 's: misses
- /ʃ/ 'ch: watches
- /ʃ/ 'sh: wishes
- /z/ 'z: causes
- /dʒ/ 'j: changes
- /ʒ/ 'zh: garages

Phát âm là /z/

- Khi các từ có tận cùng là nguyên âm và các phụ âm hữu thanh còn lại
- /b/ 'b: describes
- /g/ 'g: begs

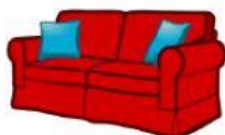

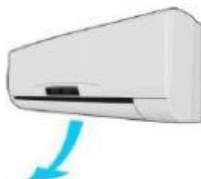
