13. bring out = publish (v): xuất hiện
14. run out of = hết (tiền, nước, xăng....)
15. look through = read sth: đọc
16. look forward to V-ing: mong mỏi làm gì?
17. come back = return = get back: trở lại, trở về
18. set off = begin a trip: bắt đầu 1 chuyến đi
