Phrases for Giving Gifts

1. I got you something. I hope you like it.
2. Look what I have for you!
3. I thought you might like this for...
4. Happy Birthday! [Happy Anniversary!] ...
5. [Handing present to someone] Enjoy!
6. It's only something small, but I hope you like it.
7. Here's a little present for you.
8. Guess what I bought you!
9. I wasn't sure what to get you but I hope you like it.
10. Hold out your hands and close your eyes!
(Then you place the present into the person's hands.)

What to say when you receive a present

- 1.Thank you so much! It's lovely / fantastic / wonderful.
- 2.It's something I've always wanted!
- 3.It's just what I've always wanted!
- 4.Wow! What a thoughtful present!
- 5.You shouldn't have!
- 6.How did you guess! It's just perfect, thank you so much!
- 7.How kind of you!
- 8.It's lovely, thank you!
9. I don't know what to say
10. The wrapping is beautiful !
