Christopher Columbus 1st voyage and Establishment of Hispaniola Portugal Sends its First African Slave ship to the Americas Vespucci's Voyage and discovery of South America, and the First Mention of "America" Christopher Columbus 3rd Voyage and arrest for treating the Indigenous people and Colonists Brutally Christopher Columbus 4th and Last Voyage Portugal Established the first colonies in Angola and Mozambique		Christopher Columbus 2nd Voyage Portugal Brings slaves to Europe Reconquista and the expulsion of Jews and Muslims from the Spanish Kingdom King Ferdinand approves licenses for slaves in the new world St. Augustine Established as one of the oldest Cities in America (Under the spanish control at the time) Martin Waldseemüller, suggested that the newly discovered world be named "from Amerigo the discovered" as if it were the land of Americus or America
