Present Simple: Positive and Negative

We use the Present Simple for facts, habits and everyday actions.

POSITIVE

I / You / We / They	verb	the rest of the sentence.
He / She / It	verb+s	the rest of the sentence.

I like pizza.

She likes pizza.

NEGATIVE

I / You / We / They	don't	verb	the rest of the sentence.
He / She / It	doesn't	verb	the rest of the sentence.

I don't like pizza.

She doesn't like pizza.
