2. Read the questions you will be asked to answer in order to focus your attention to what you will be specifically asked.
3. Listen more than once, because every time you listen again, you will understand more details than the previous time you listened to the information.
4. Focus your attention on meaningful information, like descriptions, numbers, names.
5. List the vocabulary you don't know so you can ask your teacher for the spelling/pronunciation so as to find the meaning in the dictionary or with your teacher, too.
