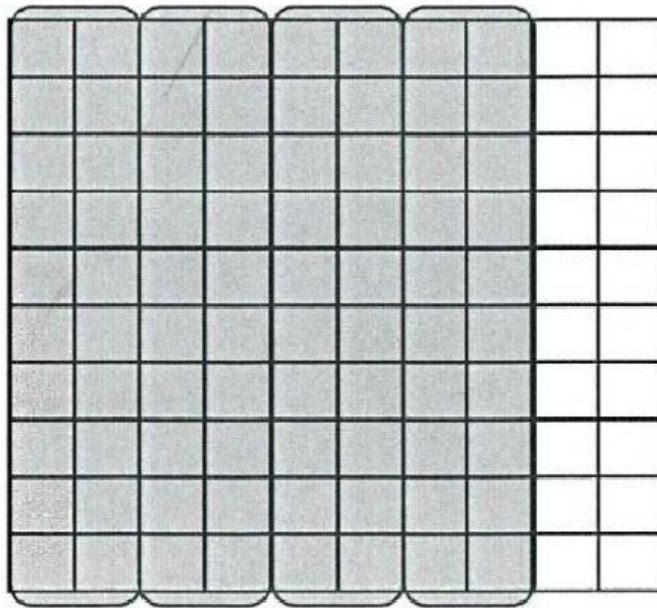


Dividing Decimals with Models Practice

5.NSBT.7

- Decimal divided by a whole is a decimal answer.
- Example: $0.5 \div 5 = 0.10$

Example: $0.8 \div 4 = 0.2$



Drag the problems to the correct models.

$$0.4 \div 5 = 0.08$$

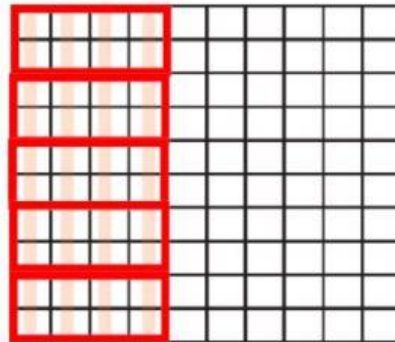
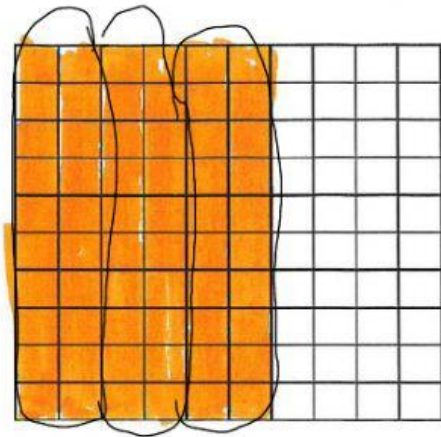
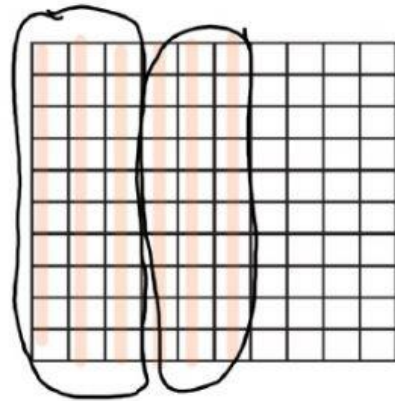
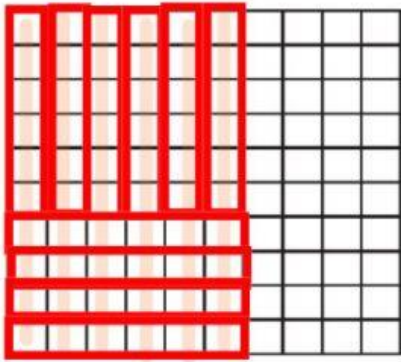
$$0.4 \div 5 = 0.8$$

$$0.40 \div 5 = 0.8$$

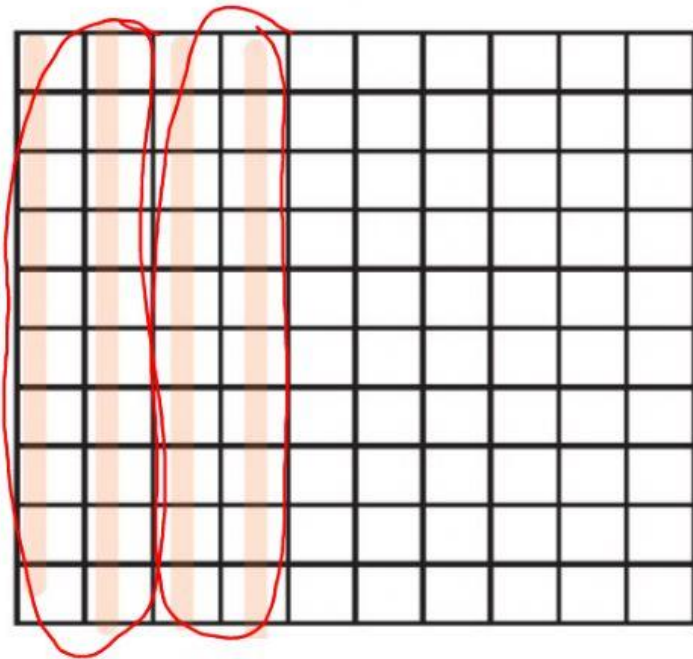
$$0.6 \div 3 = 0.2$$

$$0.6 \div 2 = 0.3$$

$$0.6 \div 10 = 0.06$$



- Decimal divided by a decimal is a whole number answer.
- Example: $0.4 \div 0.2 = 2$



Drag the problems to the correct models.

$$0.12 \div 0.02 = 6$$

$$0.60 \div 0.15 = 4$$

$$0.12 \div 6 = 0.2$$

$$0.4 \div 0.8 = 0.5$$

$$0.4 \div 0.08 = 5$$

$$0.6 \div 0.06 = 10$$
