
LET'S TRAVEL AROUND THE WORLD!


 Instructions: Use the physical world map in your atlas to answer the questions and label the oceans and continents on the map below.

- (g) The ocean also known as Antarctic Ocean, which borders Antarctica.
- (h) The continent which is west of Asia and is attached to it.
- The biggest ocean that borders eastern Asia, northeastern Australia, Antarctica, and western North and South America.
- The continent which is north of South America and is bordered by the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans.
- (k) The continent in the Northern Hemisphere, that is east of Europe.
- (I) The ocean that borders Antarctica, eastern Africa, southern Asia, and Western Australia.
