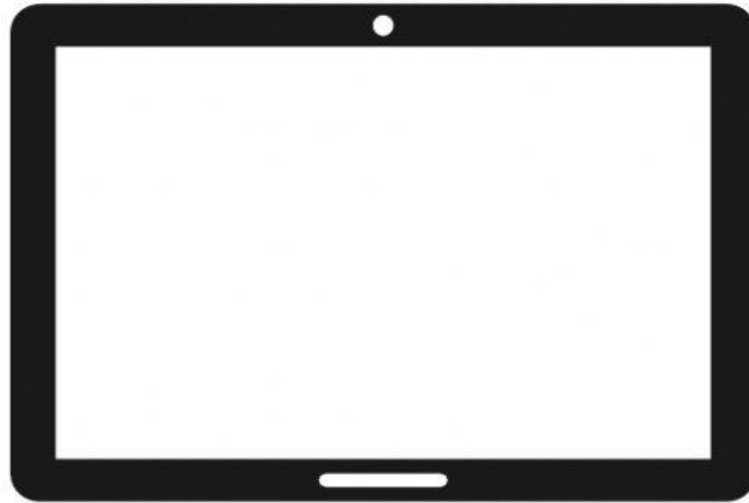


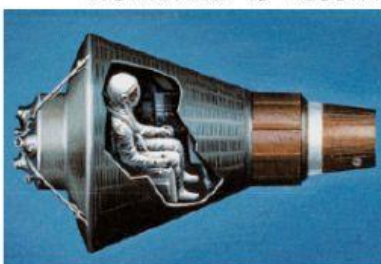
## VALENTINA TERESHKOVA

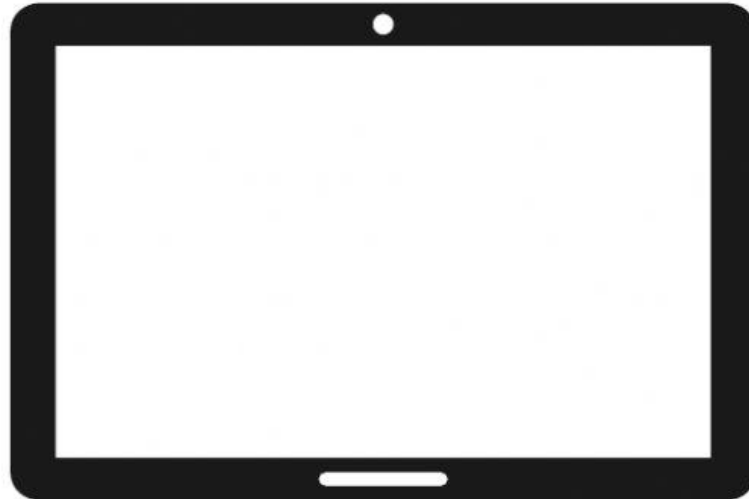
## SWIMMING THE CHANNEL
