

USING PRONOUNS CORRECTLY

PRONOUNS AS DIRECT OBJECTS

7c The *direct object* of a verb is always in the objective case.

A *direct object* is a noun or pronoun that receives the action of a verb or that shows the result of the action.

EXAMPLES The officer directed **me** to the right address. [*Me* tells *whom* the officer directed.]
Teresa gave **them** to her sister. [*Them* tells *what* Teresa gave.]

To choose the correct pronoun for use as a compound direct object, try each form of the pronoun separately.

EXAMPLE The audience applauded Geraldo and (*I, me*).
The audience applauded *I*. [incorrect use of nominative case]
The audience applauded *me*. [correct use of objective case]

ANSWER The audience applauded Geraldo and **me**.
