My name is James and I work in a secondary school in Manchester that organizes environmental projects with other schools from London and Liverpool.

Each school decides a beach to work on. Students put all the rubbish they collect in large bags and then separate it into three different coloured containers. Finally, lorries collect the containers.



GEORGE

Hi there, I am George and I study at Melbourne University. We will take part in this project from January to March. We are worried about the sea animals because they accidentally eat the plastics we throw away* in the seas and then, they get sick or die**.

We collect the rubbish from different public places. Then, we make videos for our website.
