Use the comparative or the superlative.

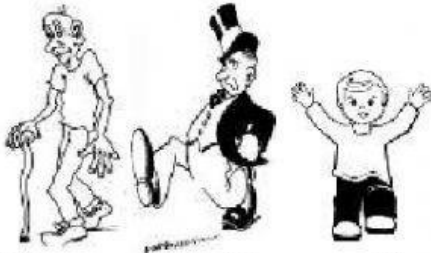


James

- 2) Oliver is than David. (old)
- 3) John is the (young)

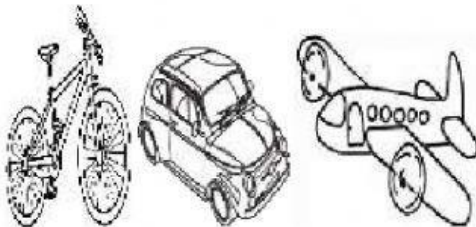


Leopard

- 1) The leopard is than the rabbit. (fast)
- 2) The rabbit is than the turtle. (slow)
- 3) The turtle is the (fast)

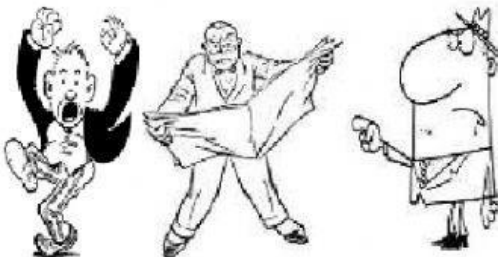


Bicycle

- 1) The bicycle is than the car. (comfortable)
- 2) The plane is than the car. (comfortable)
- 3) The plane is the (comfortable)

popular (+)

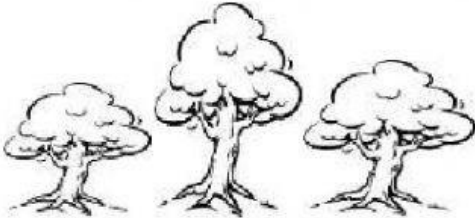


Basketball

(sad +)

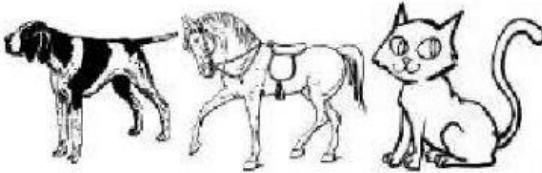


Maria

3) Jane is the (sad)

(friendly+++)

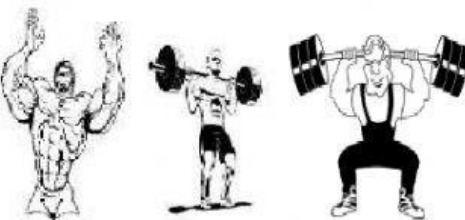
Horse

2) The cat is than the dog. (friendly)

3) The dog is the (friendly)

1) Kevin is than Bill. (strong)

2) Matthew is than Kevin. (weak)

3) Bill is the (strong)

1) Brian is than Jonathan. (Intelligent)

2) Jonathan is than Einstein. (Intelligent)

3) Einstein is the (intelligent)
