PAST TENSE			PRESENT TENSE		
I	was	sad.	I	am	happy.
He	was	poor.	He	is	rich.
She	was	a student.	She	is	a nurse.
It	was	difficult.	It	is	easy.
We	were	late.	We	are	early.
You	were	at home.	You	are	at school.
They	were	noisy.	They	are	quiet.

- Yesterday - Last month
 - Last week - Last year

- Now - Right Now
 - At the moment

EXAMPLES

I **was** sad yesterday, but I **am** happy at the moment.
 She **was** a student last year, but she **is** a nurse now.
 They **were** busy last week, but they **are** free right now.

(+) SHORT ANSWER

Yes,	I was. you were. he / she / it was. we were. you were. they were.
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(-) SHORT ANSWER

No,	I wasn't. you weren't. he / she / it wasn't. we weren't. you weren't. they weren't.
