Prepositions of place with questions and answers

We can use the verb **be** to ask **yes/no** questions. We change the word order for questions.

| Statement | Question | Answer |
|-------------------------------|-------------------------------|---------------|
| The lamp is next to the sofa. | Is the lamp next to the sofa? | Yes, it is. |
| | | No, it isn't. |

Next to, on, in, and between are prepositions of place. They tell us where something is.

| | | |
|---|---------------------------------------|-------------------------------------|
| The phone is next to the armchair. | The handbag is in the box. | The lamp is on the sofa. |
|---|---------------------------------------|-------------------------------------|

Between means "next to two things", so we use **and** to say the two things on each side.

The doll is **between** the table **and** the armchair.
