 - C. The girls got out their kites and began to fly them

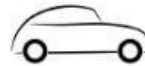

- C. Timmy helped Dad carry the box

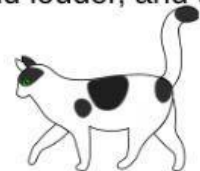
