USEFUL LANGUAGE

Describing a plan

- 1 Any actions which are taken in the first few minutes are critical.
- 2 We should make plans for any potential emergency scenario where there is a threat or emergency risk to personal safety.
- 3 The key here is to identify things which will reduce injuries, deaths or damage to property.
- 4 The next important area to consider is: how can we respond to the emergency situation?
- 5 There needs to be a clear procedure for contacting and coordinating with emergency services.
- 6 There's one final area to include, and that's how to recover from the emergency.

3) Decide on a format to present your work: poster, presentation, physical demonstration, video, etc.

4) Present your ERP to the class.
