5. _____ a shore of a body of water covered by sand, gravel, or larger rock fragments.



6. _____ the state of the atmosphere with respect to heat or cold, wetness or dryness, calm or storm, clearness or cloudiness.



7. _____ a very large expanse of sea, in particular each of the main areas into which the sea is divided geographically.



8. _____ is a river or other body of water's steep fall over a rocky ledge into a plunge pool below.



9. _____ a long-lived woody plant that has a single usually tall main stem with few or no branches on its lower part.



10. _____ landform that rises prominently above its surroundings, generally exhibiting steep slopes, a relatively confined summit area, and considerable local relief.
