

**REVIEW UNIT 4****I. Grammar** **Affirmative form:**

I/You/ We/They	He/ She/It
live, go, do, play, visit, have	lives, goes, does, plays, visits, has

Example: I live in a house. - She lives in a flat.

They play basketball on Tuesday. - He plays basketball on Tuesday.

 Negative form:

I/You/ We/They	He/ She
don't live	doesn't live
don't go	doesn't go
don't do	doesn't do
don't play	doesn't play
don't have	doesn't have
don't take photo	doesn't take photo

Example: I don't visit my grandma on Sunday.

She doesn't visit her grandma on Sunday.

 WH-questions form:

WH- questions + does+ she/he + Verb ...?

WH- questions + do+ I/you/we/they + Verb ...?

Note: WH-questions: What/Who/ Where/ Why/When / How

Example:

1. Where does he live?
2. What school does she go to?
3. Who does he play with?
