

## Conditional Sentence – Type 2 (ตรงข้ามกับความจริงในปัจจุบัน)

If + Past Simple

( If clause )

would + V1 (inf)

( main clause )

If + S + V2

S + would + V1 (inf)

Ex. If you **asked** your mom , she **would help** you.

His father **wouldn't be** angry if he **didn't tell** the lie.

If I **were** you, I **would take** the offer.
