

Present Perfect or Past Simple

The Present Perfect always connects the past and the present.

The Past Simple tells us only about the past

Key words to look at: yet, already, since, just, today, ever, never, for.

Key words to look at: ago, yesterday, when, did, at, last year/week/month etc,
